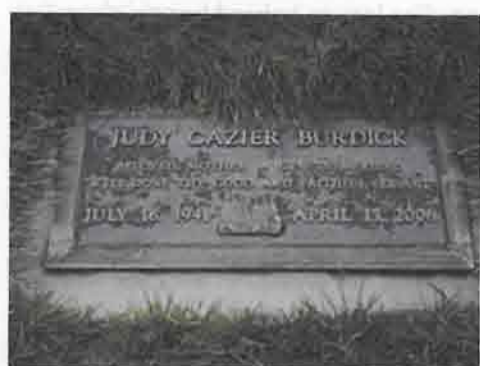

Judy Cazier Burdick, 64, of Boise died Saturday, April 15, 2006 from breast cancer. Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Thursday, April 20, at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, 3020 W. Cherry Lane in Boise. Friends may call to visit with the family on Wednesday from 6-8 p.m. at Relyea Funeral Chapel and on Thursday from 12 p.m. to 12:45 p.m. at the church prior to the services. Interment will follow at Cloverdale Cemetery in Boise. Judy was born in Park City, Utah on July 16, 1941 to Roma and Emil McCandless. Her mother later married Deloyd Cazier in 1945, who then adopted Judy and her older sister Harriette Louise. Roma and Dee had two more children, Deloyd Jr. and Eliza Dianne, before the family settled in Boise, Idaho. Judy attended Borah High School and was in Borah's first graduating class in 1959. She married the love of her life, Jim Burdick, on September 4, 1959. Their marriage was later solemnized in the Los Angeles Temple. They had two sons and a daughter and then settled in Boise where Jim became a Boise City Police officer. Judy worked for Boise Cascade. In 1974 they started their "second family." Judy stayed home with their new baby girl and the two daughters that came after, until they all started school. She returned to work as an Administrative Assistant at MONY. Jim and Judy were married 33 years until Jim died suddenly October 17, 1992. In 1999 she was diagnosed with breast cancer and underwent 18 months of chemotherapy and radiation. The cancer was in remission


until earlier this year. Judy was greatly blessed with six children, 20 grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren. She worked over thirty years as a volunteer for her church in the relief society, primary, and young women organizations. Judy edited and distributed the grade school newsletter, and worked as a Cub Scout leader even after her children were grown. The only word needed to describe her is selfless. She loved her friends and family with her whole heart. She was quick to lend an ear, to offer a meal, and to give a hug. Judy was a hard worker and often felt that she hadn't accomplished enough in any single day. She was preceded in death by her parents Roma and Dee Cazier; and husband James Eldon Burdick, her eternal companion. She leaves behind her children Col. James Deloyd (JD) Burdick of Chicago, Illinois, Bradley J. Burdick of Billings, Montana, Lisa Lou Burdick, Judyann E. Balukoff, Amberly D. Smith, and Heather JoAnn Taylor, all of Boise; her siblings Dee Cazier, Jr., Louise Adams, and Dianne Fagan; her 20 grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren. All who knew her loved her and she will be missed greatly.
