Becky Lee Reichardt, 58, died Saturday, July 3, 1999, at her home in Colorado Springs, Colo., after a long and courageous battle with cancer. She was born Jan. 13, 1941, in Boise, Idaho, to Lucy and the late Harold Morrison. She graduated from Borah High School in Boise in 1959. Becky was a Denver Broncos season ticket holder for 16 years and had a deep passion for her team. In spite of many years of cancer treatments, she missed only one home game. She was thrilled to attend the Bronco's Super Bowl XXXII victory over the Packers in San Diego with her son, Scott. Becky also enjoyed the outdoors, visiting her dear friends in France, and, above all, spending time with her grandchildren.

Becky married Jack Reichardt Oct. 21, 1972, in Albuquerque, N.M.
