

Michael S. Robinson, P.E., 76 of Canton, Michigan died on Saturday, October 21, 2017. He was 76 years old.

Born February 16, 1941 in Minneapolis, Minnesota, he was the son of the late Jesse C. Robinson and Marjorie M. Robinson.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years Nancy J. Robinson (nee Blue), his brothers Patrick and Timothy, and three daughters Julia (Kevin), Margaret (Paul), and Anne Michael (Terra) and three grandchildren Jacob, Annelise, and Hayden.

Mike and Nancy met at Colorado State University, where he graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering in 1963. A long career in Consulting Geotechnical Engineering followed which included design work for the Owens-Illinois World Headquarters in Toledo, Ohio, the modernization of the Houston water reclamation system, and the Milwaukee Deep Tunnel works. Because of his expertise, he was called upon to provide expert testimony in forensic engineering.

In addition to his passion for engineering, Mike was also known for his love of music, reading, and scientific curiosity, which he passed on to his daughters. He became an Episcopalian in 1962 and was involved in church music, acolyte training, and, most notably as a lay reader. He served as the Senior Warden at his former parish, St. David's.
