Our precious and much-loved Gail had such a humble, sweet spirit. She passed away on October 24, 2023.

Gail was born a triplet along with her brother Gordon and her sister Gretchen on February 24, 1941, in Kansas City, Mo to Esther and George Phelps Toler. Gail spent most of her childhood in Jerome, Idaho and then her parents moved to Boise, Idaho. Gail graduated from Borah High School in Boise in 1959 where she was active in several clubs. Gail attended Boise Jr. College where she met Jack Klinchuch in a dance class. They grew in friendship and got married on September 3, 1961. Gail helped support Jack's last year at the University of Idaho by working for Professor Hosak. Gail and Jack moved to Orange, California upon Jack's graduation where Jack was offered a job as an aerospace engineer. While in Orange, her daughter Karen was born in 1963 and her son Brent was born in 1965. They later moved to Trabuco Canyon, California and they lived for over 50 years total in California.
