

Rosary for Charles A. Walhof, 31, of 1418 North Seventeenth, who died of natural causes Thursday evening in a Boise hospital, will be recited at 7:30 this evening at Summers Funeral Home. Services will be conducted at 9:30 a.m. Monday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church by Fr. Roger LaChance. Interment will be at Morris Hill.

Both Jan. 5, 1941, in Twin Falls, he came to Boise 18 years ago from Magic Valley. On Oct. 26, 1968, he married Ramona Willoughby in Boise. At the time of his death he was a job counselor for the State Commission for the Blind. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, the Boise Ranch Lions Club, the National

Federation of the Blind and the Gem State Blind Association.

Surviving are his wife, a daughter, Laura, a son, Christopher Walhof, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. Bernard Walhof, and a brother, John B. Walhof, all of Boise; and two sisters, Helen Rutherford of Stony Brook, N.Y., and Nancy Utpadel of Anchorage, Alaska.
